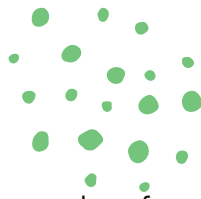


My First Look



Transformation Church uses the My First Look Curriculum for Babies, Toddlers and Preschoolers. We believe that this curriculum is theologically sound and developmentally appropriate.

Your child's spiritual foundation begins at birth. In our Baby Room, our leaders create a place where babies get their first glimpse of their Heavenly Father and His Church. Babies are prayed over, cared for and sing simple songs.

In the Toddler room, we focus on one Bible Story each month. In addition to sharing the story, we sing worship songs and do a simple craft each Sunday.

Preschool Kids have opening activities, large group (Bible Story, Scripture, Prayer and Worship) and end the day with a hands on activities that reinforce the message. Everything that we do reflects one of our 3 basic truths.

Transformation Church uses 252KIDS for elementary aged kids. This is based on Luke 2:52 (And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature, and in favor with God and man.) Through Biblical teachings, interactive games, worship, hands on activities and small group discussions. Each week, we focus on one of these three basic truths:

THREE BASIC TRUTHS

I need to make the wise choice.

I can trust God no matter what.

I should treat others the way I want to be treated.

We want to make sure kids don't just believe the right things but these truths begin to transform their lives. In other words, we want them to do something with what they've heard. That's why each week, we not only discover truth but we give kids specific and actionable ways to apply that truth in their lives.

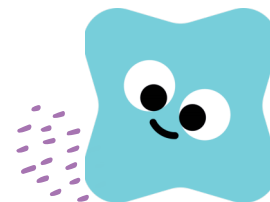

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Check-In & Dismissal

Make sure your child has checked-in and is wearing their nametag before dropping him or her off in their room. You should receive a parent tag. You will need this to enter the children's areas and at the door to pick up your child.

Restrooms

Volunteers will never go into the bathroom alone with your child. If your child needs help, two adults will assist your child.

Diaper Changing Policies

Volunteers are trained to wear gloves and sanitize the changing area. Other adults are around during the process and will let you know that your child has been changed.

Discipline

If your child is having trouble following the guidelines that have been put in place, the volunteers will first try directing your child's behavior. If that doesn't work, the director will be contacted so that he or she can handle the situation apart from your child's small group.

Incident Report

If a child is injured in a classroom, we ask that the volunteers let their director know exactly what happened. We then take a full incident report and communicate the injury clearly to parents.

Crying Policy

On occasion, we will have babies and toddlers who cry when being dropped off. Our leaders will do their best to divert their attention and engage them in playtime. If they are inconsolable after 5 minutes, we will text you to return to your child's room.

First Aid Kits

First aid kits are readily available to our volunteers and placed throughout the children's ministry environments.

Fire Evacuation Plan

Our church has an emergency evacuation plan in place. There is a map on the wall by the door of each classroom with the emergency exit route, along with a red bag containing everything volunteers will need to execute the emergency evacuation plan and lead the children to safety.

Toy Cleaning

We spray each toy with antibacterial spray and let them all air dry after all of the children have left.

Allergies

Please communicate any allergies your child may have to the volunteers working with your child.

Sickness Policy

To ensure the well being of our kids and leaders, we parents to keep their child home if they have any of these symptoms:

- unexplained rash
- excessive cough
- drainage from ears or nose that has a green tint
- diarrhea (2 or more loose bowel movements in a 30 minute period) child be fever free for at least 24
- pink eye
- lice/nits
- fever over 100.5 in the last 24 hours

Label Belongings

Please label bottles, sippy cups and other personal items. The baby and toddler rooms have bag tags for your use as well.
